	٠	The new banking contract and the ability to pay bills at post office branches is good and			
9, 10		generates footfall. However the cost of <del>transferring <u>the</u> cash <u>supply chain</u> needs to reduce</del>			
11, 12	•	Going forwardIn the longer term, Post Office Limited should could refocus to be a small			
13, 14, 15		<u>"buying unit"</u> that conducts contract negotiations on behalf of Sub postmasters <u>, although TP</u>			
		stressed that any such plans were still at a very early stage.			
16	٠	TP thought the new non execs are a good addition to the board and the new <u>Chief</u> Financial			
17		Director Officer was also good quality.			
18, 19	•	BNR raised the <u>recent</u> accounting issue <u>restatement</u> as the numbers seemed quite big. TP			
		reassured her that it was a provisioning item and would not affect overall figures. The			
		revised accounts were due to go out on Friday 29/1.			
	•	TP updated on the HORIZON investigation. He said that the QC was about to report. He had			
		found no systemic problem. TP thought the issue might have passed it peak interest.			
	•	Finally TP updated the Minister on IT and what is being done to reduce costs.
